We ask for your assistance to **help us deliver this information to your pharmacy residents and the pharmacy residents throughout your organizations!**

The Connecticut Society of Health System Pharmacists (CSHP) is offering Connecticut PGY1 and PGY2 pharmacy residents the opportunity to submit a clinical pearl for presentation at the Greg Gousse Residency Conference, part of the annual *Catch the Wave* event, on **November 9th, 2022**.

The pearls can be any topic of choice that addresses a clinical issue. All submissions should include the following sections:

- Needs Assessment
- Planned Learning Assessment
- Abstract
- Objective (see attached for guidance).

Once submitted, a panel of judges will evaluate each abstract based on an objective rubric and select the **top 8 abstracts**. The selected abstracts will be presented in a platform format at the meeting - each 8 minutes in length with 2 minutes for questions and answers. **A guideline for clinical pearls is attached.**

Important deadlines:

- **Deadline for abstract submission via email to Jessica Carona (jessica.vitalcarona@ynhh.org): September 30, 2022**
- Candidates will be notified of results: **October 5, 2022**

Important! Residents that are chosen to present clinical pearls will receive free registration to *Catch the Wave 2022*

Requirements:

1. PGY1 or PGY2 resident in a Connecticut residency program
2. Member of CSHP in good standing (applicant may submit CSHP application and dues with their abstract)
3. 3. If accepted, must present **in person** on November 9th meeting
